The Megabuck Singles format is designed to be the be the Main Event, guaranteeing a large first place prize that all bowlers love to see. The 2 full qualifying squads are 5 games, and advance 1:5 to the semi-final. Re-entries are allowed. The Semi-Final is a 3 game squad with no carryover from qualifying. The top 3 from that squad advance to a 3 game final, which I film and commentate for YouTube

I guarantee \$1000 for the singles event, with a \$80 entry fee. \$1 of the entry fee is withheld for the Tournament of Champions and \$1.50 is withheld for the yearly Grand Finals.

The Doubles format is a fun, fast, single squad event that features 5 games of qualifying, moving one pair to the right after each game. The entry fee is \$70/person, and there is a \$5 Guest fee.

After the qualifying is over, I pay 1:4, but the top 3 advance to a stepladder final, if we have at least 12 teams. Additional stepladder teams are added if we have more than 28 teams. I film the final match for YouTube as well. There is no guaranteed money in this format. Mixed Doubles require one female per team to be eligible to compete.

The Trios format is the same format as the Doubles, just with 3 person teams. It is a little slower than the Doubles, but is still not a long day.

After the qualifying is over, I pay 1:4, but the top 3 advance to a stepladder final, if we have at least 12 teams. Additional stepladder teams are added if we have more than 28 teams. I film the final match for YouTube as well. There is no guaranteed money in this format. I max at 3 teams per pair, which requires one team to be split on each pair. Mixed Trios require one female per team to be eligible to compete.

The Team Challenge is a take on a popular local series of events that require specific team composition. The event is a Swiss format, comprised of 6 games. It is all handicap, and unlike other Swiss events, lineups are up to the team, where other Swiss events are ordered by average.

Teams are required to have at least 1 woman and 1 Senior bowler aged 50 or older. There is no stepladder and points are 8 per game. Cost is \$80/person and add \$5 for Guests.

The Eliminator Doubles is a format I created several years ago.

Teams of 2 bowl 5 games of qualifying to determine the top 16 teams in order of pinfall. There is no restriction on teams composition. Cost is \$70/person, and add \$5 for Guests

Once all qualifying is done, the top 16 teams are seeded into a bracket. Teams bowl heads up in one game total pins matches. The winning team advances and the losing team goes home. This continues until there is one team left standing. Depending on entries, teams will likely need to win round 1 to cash. If we have more than 48 teams, it is possible that teams could cash if they lose round 1, but it is solely based upon entries.

The Quad Swiss is a popular event in the Northwest.

The event is all match play and is position round every game. Teams randomly choose a starting lane and bowl heads up with handicap against the other team in individual and team matches. The event does not include a stepladder. Cost is \$80/person, with an additional \$5 for Guests

The Quad Swiss is only run 5 times a year in order to keep it special. I start taking entries about a month in advance and commonly fill quickly.

The TOC is a once a year event and is the penultimate event of my season. All previous branch champions are eligible, and it is a life-time eligibility. Entry is \$80 and is a very unique and challenging format.

Bowlers bowl 4 games of qualifying and then we cut to the top 16 bowlers. Those 16 will be seeded based on score into a single elimination bracket, ala March Madness. One game matches occur until one bowler is left standing.

The winner gets a Special Gold Jersey from Logo Infusion. I have worked on a design with them and they do a great job. We also have added money in this event, starting this season. We take \$1 from each entry at each event and applying that to this event. This should add almost \$1500 to the prize fund. This has been a great entry driver this season. It is a gala event, as each entry is announced with their hometown and number of titles won.

Points are earned via event entry
and cashing.

The Grand Finals is the final event of the season. All during the year, points are earned. Bowlers earn points for each event they bowl. 20 points for each event. They can only earn additional points if they cash. 30 Bonus Points are awarded for a win, 20 for 2nd, 10 for 3rd, and then 5 points for any other cash.

At the end of the season, the top 16 in points are invited to take place in a special event. Cost is \$75 per person. All bowlers bowl 5 games, moving one pair to the right after each game. At the end of 5 games, the field is cut in half. The rest of the field bowls an additional game, another half field cut. Another game and another cut. This leaves two bowlers. Those two bowlers have their reset to 0 and they bowl a best 2 out of 3 final match to determine the champion.

Winner gets a Special Platinum Jersey for the win. We also have added money as \$1.50 from every entry during the season is added to the prize fund for this event, adding over \$2000 to the event prize fund.

If a member of the top 16 cannot bowl, then the next person in line gets the call until 16 have been confirmed. All 16 bowlers are paid a minimum of their entry fee back, but commonly more.
